Sealed BIDS will be received at the City of Dayton, Texas City Hall, 117 Cook St, Dayton, TX 77535, until **2:00 p.m. Local Time, Thursday, January 20, 2022** and then publicly opened and read for **“Dayton Downtown Revitalization Project (DRP) TxCDBG Contract Number 721942.”** Address bids to City of Dayton, Attention Ms. Kimberly Judge, Assistant City Manager.
- B. BIDS received after the closing time will be returned unopened. All bidders are invited attend the non-mandatory pre-bid conference as described in SECTION 00 11 04: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS. **The non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, January 5, 2022.** Local Time. The meeting will be held at City of Dayton, Texas City Hall, 117 Cook St, Dayton, TX 77535.
- C. Major items of work include rehabilitation and repair of concrete sidewalks, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) complaint ramps, and driveways in Dayton’s downtown area.
- D. Each BID shall be accompanied by a bid security, in an amount not less than 5 percent of the total amount bid, according to SECTION 00 11 16 II: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.
